

WALKING FIELD TRIPS and NEIGHBOURHOOD ACTIVITIES PERMISSION FORM 2026-2027

Occasionally, students will be walking in the community to a specific site or for a school based activity like the Terry Fox Run. Students will be supervised by staff and volunteers, however, students will be expected to observe the following safety rules:

- Students must follow school expectations while on our walks.
- Students must remain visible to the teacher at all times.
- Students must observe all traffic rules.
- Students must demonstrate respect for the property of others.
- Students must demonstrate respect for others using the same sidewalk.

Failure to observe these rules will result in the student having to remain behind at the school or other disciplinary action.

While on neighborhood walks, staff will be carrying a cell phone and a first aid kit, and other safety equipment to ensure a safe and positive learning experience. In the event that we need to cross any streets. Special events will also involve safety rules that may be modified for the event. Classroom teachers will communicate with families prior to events. Volunteers will be welcomed.
